With the arrival of spring, comes draft planning for the upcoming school year. Given the average student enrollment over the last three years, our teacher full time equivalency has been reduced by .39 for the 2021-2022 school year. We have also been allocated fewer Educational Assistants. Despite these reduced staff allocations, our planning continues to be student centered and is focused on school and division priorities.

At this time, we anticipate 6 homeroom classes with 2 classes at each grade level. The only confirmed staffing change is in Grade 4. Mrs. Millis has accepted a temporary Assistant Principal position at Canyon School for 2021-2022. We wish her the best as she pursues an interest in school leadership!
