March 1st and March 8th- Pass Powderkeg Programming continues:

(Regular bussing is in place at the start and end of this school day)

Students will leave ISS by 8:45am to board the bus to the lodge or walk over to the T-Bar with their gear. Programming at PPK begins at 9am.
